






	Age Restriction	Frequency	Transfers from a 4-Year Institution
Questionnaires, Camp Info., NCAA Materials & Nonathletic Publications	May send to a PSA of any age.	UNLIMITED	*ANYTIME
 Recruiting Materials (hard letters/snail mail)	No earlier than <b>September 1</b> of junior year	UNLIMITED <small>Restricted only by size of letter (8.5" x 11" when opened in full)</small>	*ANYTIME
 Electronic Correspondence (email/texting/faxes)	No earlier than <b>September 1</b> of junior year	UNLIMITED <small>Must be private between sender and recipient (NO public posts)</small>	*ANYTIME
 Telephone Calls	Between <b>July 7 - July 31</b> after sophomore year for residents of a foreign country	Only <b>one call</b> per PSA	*ANYTIME
	No earlier than <b>September 1</b> of junior year	UNLIMITED	
 Off-Campus (In-Person) Contacts	No earlier than <b>July 7</b> following junior year	No more than 3 per PSA <i>See limit below</i>	*ONLY AFTER <b>October 15</b> following PSA's completion of High School, may coaches make 3 additional off-campus contacts
 Official Visits	No earlier than opening day of classes of PSA's <b>senior year</b>	Only <b>1</b> official visit is permitted per PSA, regardless if multi-sport athlete	*ONLY AFTER <b>October 15</b> following PSA's completion of High School, the PSA may receive an additional official visit if taken one already.
 Evaluation & Contact Limits	<p align="center"><b><u>Max. of 7 Recruiting Opportunities per PSA, per year.</u></b></p> <p>Recruiting opportunities are contacts &amp; evaluations combined per PSA, per year (<i>Aug 1 - July 31</i>). Evaluations taking place from June 1 through August 31 do not count against this limit. Off-campus, in-person contacts count against this limit, regardless of time of year. An evaluation that takes place the same day as a permissible contact, counts as only a contact.</p>
