Series History

USC Upstate: *Upstate leads 19-5-3*
 Upstate is the program that PC is most familiar with on their schedule, the two teams have played each other 27 times and every season since 2007. The last Blue Hose victory came in 2013, a 4-3 overtime victory for PC.

Elon: *PC leads 6-2-2*
 The Blue Hose and Pheonix have played each other 10 times but not since 2013. 2013 is the only time the two teams have faced each other at the Division I level. Elon won that match by a 3-0 score.

Jonathan Potter is entering his second season as head coach of the Presbyterian College men's soccer team in 2017.

In his first year at the helm, Potter guided the Blue Hose to a 7-10-3 overall record with a 4-4 mark in conference play. The seven wins marked the third biggest turnaround last season in NCAA DI and is the most wins in a season in program history. The No. 5 seed in the Big South Championship, PC upset fourth-seeded Liberty 2-1 on November 6 for the program's first ever victory in the conference tournament. The Blue Hose faced top-seeded Radford in the program's first-ever semifinal appearance, falling to the Highlanders on penalty kicks after playing to a 1-1 draw in regulation. Potter saw four players earn annual awards, to include a pair making Second Team All-Big South, one Honorable Mention and an All-Freshman honoree.

Prior to PC, Potter spent five seasons at Elon as an assistant coach where he helped the Phoenix win five conference championships and several NCAA Tournament appearances, including advancing to the second round in 2013 and 2015.

Potter, who holds a "B" US Soccer Federation Coaching License and an advanced diploma from the NCSAA, also served as the director of men's soccer operations at Davidson College, where he assisted in training, filming, editing, and analysis.

A four-year starter at Chowan, Potter appeared in all but one match during his career. He holds a bachelor's degree in physical education with a concentration in sport management and a minor in business administration. He earned his master's degree in athletic coaching education from West Virginia University in 2012.

In 2009 he trained with a professional team in Argentina and prior to that, played in the United Soccer League with a Northern Virginia Royals' super-20 team that reached the 2008 North American finals.

Potter is married to the former Melissa Cochran of Macon, Ga.

Scouting the Competition

USC Upstate:



• The USC Upstate Spartans come into this match sporting an 0-2 record after the first week of the men's soccer season. They were defeated by South Carolina, 2-1 and Georgia State, 2-0.

• Cam Philpot has scored their one goal in two matches as he was assisted by Calon Minors.

• Santiago Restrepo is the Spartan leader in goal, he has recorded five saves while allowing four goals.

• The Spartans are led by first year head coach Scott Halkett. While it is his first year as head coach he is in his fifth season with the Spartans. He is a 1996 graduate of USC Upstate.

• The last Blue Hose victory in the series came in 2013, a 4-3 overtime victory.

Elon:



• The Elon Pheonix come into this meeting withe the Blue Hose sporting a 1-0-1 record. They played Fordham and Central Florida in neutral site contests.

• The Pheonix and Fordham tied in a 0-0 contest to open the season and then Elon defeated Central Florida by a 1-0 score.

• Elijah Agu scored the lone goal for Elon while being assisted by Jaiden Fortune.

• The Pheonix are led by first year head coach Marc Reeves. Prior to joining Elon he was the head coach at Radford from 2010-2016. In seven seasons with the Highlanders he had a career record of 75-43-20. With a 1-0-1 start at Elon he is now 76-43-21.

• The Blue Hose and Pheonix have only played each other one time in Division I level with Elon winning that 2013 match-up by a 3-0 score. Overall PC leads the series 6-2-2 with the first meeting coming in 1989.

Youth Movement

- The freshmen make up the largest class for the team this season, with 16 on the roster.
- There are 15 true freshmen and one redshirt freshman on the roster. Seven play defense, two play midfield, six play forward and one plays goalie.
- Sophomore forward, Sergio Pinto, is the leading returning scorer as he scored four goals and had three assists for 11 points in his freshman season.

Non-Conference Opponents

- The Blue Hose improved in 2016 going 2-6-2 last year in non-conference action after finishing winless in 2015.

The Blue Hose at Home

- PC is 18-51-3 at Martin Stadium since moving to Division I. Last year's squad went 4-3-1 at home. It was the first time finishing over .500 since making the jump to Division I, they also finished exactly .500 in 2009 going 3-3-1.

Opening Day Part 2

- The Blue Hose were defeated in their season opener on Saturday but on Wednesday night they have their home opener.
- Presbyterian is 24-16-0 in home openers. The Blue Hose are 1-1 when facing Upstate in their home opener.

Series History

- The Blue Hose have faced the Spartans 27 times in program history. That is the second most matches versus any one opponent in school history. They have played Lander 29 times.
- PC is currently on a three match slide vs Upstate. Their last win came in 2013, 4-3 in overtime.
- Presbyterian has a winning record overall vs the Pheonix of Elon as they are 6-2-2 all-time. The two teams have only played each other once in the Division I era. In 2013 Elon defeated PC by a 3-0 score.

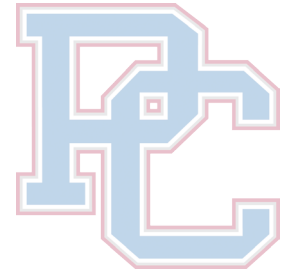
