Jonathan Potter is entering his second season as head coach of the Presbyterian College men's soccer team in 2017.

In his first year at the helm, Potter guided the Blue Hose to a 7-10-3 overall record with a 4-4 mark in conference play. The seven wins marked the third biggest turnaround last season in NCAA DI and is the most wins in a season in program history. The No. 5 seed in the Big South Championship, PC upset fourth-seeded Liberty 2-1 on November 6 for the program's first ever victory in the conference tournament. The Blue Hose faced top-seeded Radford in the program's first-ever semifinal appearance, falling to the Highlanders on penalty kicks after playing to a 1-1 draw in regulation. Potter saw four players earn annual awards, to include a pair making Second Team All-Big South, one Honorable Mention and an All-Freshman honoree.

Prior to PC, Potter spent five seasons at Elon as an assistant coach where he helped the Phoenix win five conference championships and several NCAA Tournament appearances, including advancing to the second round in 2013 and 2015.

Potter, who holds a "B" US Soccer Federation Coaching License and an advanced diploma from the NCSAA, also served as the director of men's soccer operations at Davidson College, where he assisted in training, filming, editing, and analysis.

A four-year starter at Chowan, Potter appeared in all but one match during his career. He holds a bachelor's degree in physical education with a concentration in sport management and a minor in business administration. He earned his master's degree in athletic coaching education from West Virginia University in 2012.

In 2009 he trained with a professional team in Argentina and prior to that, played in the United Soccer League with a Northern Virginia Royals' super-20 team that reached the 2008 North American finals.

Potter is married to the former Melissa Cochran of Macon, Ga.

**Scouting the Competition**

**DUKE:**



• The Duke Blue Devils are riding a three match win streak into this contest. They are 3-0-2 overall following a pair of 1-1 ties at the Shindigz National Soccer Festival in Fort Wayne, Ind.

• Duke is led by Markus Fjortoft, Ciaran McKenna and Brian White who have all scored two goals so far this season. Suniel Veerakone and Daniel Wright lead the way with two assists each.

• Will Pulisic is the leader in goal for the Blue Devils as he has played 275:21 minutes in goal in three matches allowing two goals and recording seven saves. That gives him a .778 save percentage for the season.

• Duke is led by John Kerr, a 1987 Duke alum and 1986 Hermann Trophy winner. He is in his ninth season as the head coach of the Blue Devils and has posted an 80-58-20 record while at Duke. He is 161-117-33 overall entering this season.

• The last Blue Hose have never defeated the Blue Devils in three tries.

**UNCG:**



• The UNCG Spartans come into this match with a 0-3-1 record on the season. They are fresh off of a 2-1 defeat versus the number three ranked North Carolina Tar Heels on Labor Day Monday night.

• Sandro Bradara and Alex Henderson each have scored one goal this season while Nelson Oceano has recorded an assist for the Spartans.

• Jon Milligan has played all 380:00 minutes in goal while allowing six goals and recording 17 saves. That is good for a .739 save percentage.

• The Spartans are led by eighth year head coach Justin Maullin. Maullin has been at UNCG for 13 years overall.

• PC and UNCG have met one time overall and that was in 2016. The Spartans won by a 3-2 score.

### **Youth Movement**

- The freshmen make up the largest class for the team this season, with 16 on the roster.
- There are 15 true freshmen and one redshirt freshman on the roster. Seven play defense, two play midfield, six play forward and one plays goalie.
- Sophomore forward, Sergio Pinto, is the leading returning scorer as he scored four goals and had three assists for 11 points in his freshman season.

### **Non-Conference Opponents**

- The Blue Hose improved in 2016 going 2-6-2 last year in non-conference action after finishing winless in 2015.

### **Blue Hose vs the state of North Carolina**

- PC plays in the state of North Carolina six times in 2017. The Duke game will be the third match played in N.C. in the first four matches and UNCG will be their fourth in five matches. Overall they play nine teams from N.C.

### **Team Balance**

- The Blue Hose have been a very balanced team on the offensive end so far. Four different guys have scored the Blue Hose four different goals and three more have contributed assists. This means that seven different players have contributed to the 11 points on the season.

### **Serie History**

- PC and Duke will meet for just the fourth time in program history on Tuesday evening. The first three meetings took place from 2009-2012. The Blue Devils have won all three meetings.
- The Blue Hose and Sparts had never played each other in soccer prior to 2016. The Spartans won that contest by a 3-2 score. After UNCG took a 2-0 lead PC was able to score back to back and tie it up at 2-2 before the Spartans scored the dagger in the final minute of play.

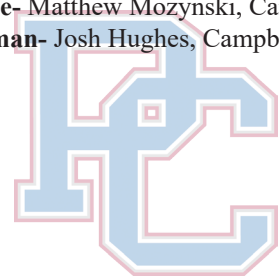
