Jonathan Potter is entering his second season as head coach of the Presbyterian College men's soccer team in 2017.

In his first year at the helm, Potter guided the Blue Hose to a 7-10-3 overall record with a 4-4 mark in conference play. The seven wins marked the third biggest turnaround last season in NCAA DI and is the most wins in a season in program history. The No. 5 seed in the Big South Championship, PC upset fourth-seeded Liberty 2-1 on November 6 for the program's first ever victory in the conference tournament. The Blue Hose faced top-seeded Radford in the program's first-ever semifinal appearance, falling to the Highlanders on penalty kicks after playing to a 1-1 draw in regulation. Potter saw four players earn annual awards, to include a pair making Second Team All-Big South, one Honorable Mention and an All-Freshman honoree.

Prior to PC, Potter spent five seasons at Elon as an assistant coach where he helped the Phoenix win five conference championships and several NCAA Tournament appearances, including advancing to the second round in 2013 and 2015.

Potter, who holds a "B" US Soccer Federation Coaching License and an advanced diploma from the NCSAA, also served as the director of men's soccer operations at Davidson College, where he assisted in training, filming, editing, and analysis.

A four-year starter at Chowan, Potter appeared in all but one match during his career. He holds a bachelor's degree in physical education with a concentration in sport management and a minor in business administration. He earned his master's degree in athletic coaching education from West Virginia University in 2012.

In 2009 he trained with a professional team in Argentina and prior to that, played in the United Soccer League with a Northern Virginia Royals' super-20 team that reached the 2008 North American finals.

Potter is married to the former Melissa Cochran of Macon, Ga.

Scouting the Competition

Radford:



- The Radford Highlanders come into this game with a 6-2-1 record on the season, 2-0 in Big South play. They have won four straight heading into this game. The Highlanders have outscored their two conference opponents 9-1.

- The Highlanders have scored 23 goals on the season for 2.56 goals per game and allows 1.00 goals. They have a .168 shot percentage and allows a .101 shot percentage. Radford is +4 in corner kicks on the season.

- Kieran Roberts, the attacking player of the week last week, is the leader in goals with 11 and 22 points. Sivert Daehlie is second with 17 points (seven goals, three assists). Evan Szklennik leads the way with six assists.

- Nicolas Mertzokat is the only goal keeper to have played this season as he has played all 830 minutes in goal allowing nine goals with a .719 save percentage. He also has a 0.98 goals allowed percentage.

- Bryheem Hancock is the head coach of the Highlanders in his first season. He is off to a 6-2-1 start.

Longwood:



- The Longwood Lancers are off to an 0-9-1 start and 0-2 in the Big South. They tied VMI in the season opener and have since lost nine straight.

- The Lancers have scored three goals on the season for a 0.33 goals per game average while allowing 15 on the season.

- Marten Pnjunurm has scored three points (one goal, one assist) to lead the way.

- Lance Da Silva has played all 841:29 minutes in goal this season. He has a 1.60 goals allowed average and a .737 save percentage (42 saves and 15 goals allowed).

- Jon Atkinson is in his 12th season as the head coach at Longwood, he has a 75-107-31 record heading into the season.

Youth Movement

- The freshmen make up the largest class for the team this season, with 16 on the roster.
- There are 15 true freshmen and one redshirt freshman on the roster. Seven play defense, two play midfield, six play forward and one plays goalie.
- Sophomore forward, Sergio Pinto, is the leading returning scorer as he scored four goals and had three assists for 11 points in his freshman season.

Non-Conference Opponents

- The Blue Hose improved in 2016 going 2-6-2 last year in non-conference action after finishing winless in 2015. In 2017 the Blue Hose are 2-4-1 in non-conference play with one remaining against Appalachian State at the end of the season.

Blue Hose in Big South Play

- PC is 1-1 in their first two Big South games this season and now host the number one team in the Big South, Radford, on Wednesday night. They then travel to Longwood on Saturday. Longwood is in last place in the Big South.

Serie History

- PC and Radford have played each other ten times with Radford leading 7-2-1. The last Blue Hose victory came in 2011. The Blue Hose and Lancers have played seven times with Longwood leading 4-3-0, PC won in 2016 by a 2-0 score.
