From the North: N.J. Turnpike to Exit 6 (Pa. Turnpike connector). Follow Pa. Turnpike to Exit 20 (Rt. 476). Follow 476 South to Rt. 76 East, towards Philadelphia. Follow Rt. 76 East to Exit 339 (Rt. 1 South, City Avenue). Turn left on 54th Street and turn right into parking lot. Hagan Arena is on the left.

From the East: Take either the Ben Franklin Bridge (via Rt. 676) or the Walt Whitman Bridge. Follow Rt. 76 West to Exit 339 (Rt. 1 South, City Avenue). Turn left on 54th Street and then right into parking lot. Hagan Arena is on the left.

From the South: I-95 North to 476 North. Follow 476 North to Exit 5 (Rt. 1). Follow Rt. 1 North to SJU, approximately 10 miles. Turn right on 54th Street and turn right into parking lot. Hagan Arena is on the left.

From the West: Pa. Turnpike to Exit 326 (Valley Forge). Follow Rt. 76 East, towards Philadelphia, to Exit 339 (Rt. 1 South, City Avenue). Turn left on 54th Street and turn right into parking lot. Hagan Arena is on the left.

THE COACHES

ERIN BROOKS

Beginning her first season as head coach of the Saint Joseph's softball program is Erin Brooks.



Named the eighth head coach in SJU history in November of 2017, Brooks brings a decade of head coaching experience to Hawk Hill as she has led her teams to a 230-166-1 overall record with eight appearances in the conference tournament and three in the NCAA Tournament. Over the last three seasons, she has served as head coach at Haverford College, leading the Fords to their first NCAA Division III Super Regional appearance in 2016.

Brooks, who served as head coach at Pacific Lutheran in 2013-14, began her head coaching career at John Carroll in 2007-08. Managing the Blue Streak for six years, she led them to two NCAA Division III Tournament berths, two NFCA Louisville Slugger All-Americans and a 154-89 record.

A 2001 NFCA Division III Second Team All-America honoree at Cabrini before transferring to Fordham. A two-year starter with the Rams, Brooks was named a Verizon Academic All-America selection in 2003 and 2004 and inducted into the Fordham Athletic Hall of Fame in 2015.

JEN MINEAU

Former All-American pitcher Jen Mineau begins her fourth season as an assistant coach at Saint Joseph's.



During her tenure with the Hawks, SJU has ranked among the league leaders in ERA, strikeouts and victories, while several student-athletes have garnered individual honors, most recently in 2017 as Ashley Ventura garnered A-10 All-conference accolades.

Mineau, who also served as an assistant and eventual interim head coach at Seton Hill, is regarded as one of the top pitchers to play in the Atlantic 10. Named a First Team All-American as a sophomore and Third Team selection as a junior, she led the Rams to their first A-10 title (2011) and a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances (2010, 2011). Mineau set 16 records including the career marks for wins (101), strikeouts (1,390) and ERA (1.42). Selected 15th overall in the 2012 National Pro Fastpitch League College Draft, Mineau played two years with the Akron Racers.

SARAH YOOS

One of the top infielders in Saint Joseph's history, Sarah Yoos is in her second season on the Hawks' bench as an assistant coach.



Ranking third all-time in RBIs (122), tied for fifth in home runs (20) and 17th in career hits (162), the four-year starter twice garnered A-10 All-Conference honors and was named A-10 Rookie of the Year in 2013. As a senior, Yoos helped lead the Hawks to the title game of the A-10 Championship and earned All-Tournament Team honors in the process. Additionally, she set a new single-season record (13) and tied for fourth in RBIs (45).
