- Broke the school record for best 54-hole total at the Franklin Street Partners Invitational with a 14-under-par score of 850 and then broke the same record the next tournament at the Stanford/Pepsi Intercollegiate with an 845 (19-under-par). Broke the record for the third time this season with an 838 at the ACC Championship.
 - Broke the school record for best 36-hole total at the Franklin Street Partners Invitational with a 12-under-par score of 564 --- then broke the same record the next tournament at the Stanford/Pepsi Intercollegiate with a 559 (17-under-par) --- for the third straight week broke the record with a 552 at the ACC/SEC Challenge
 - Broke the school record for 18 holes as a team with a 276 during the first round of the ACC/SEC Challenge. Matched the record in round two with a 276. In the final round of the ACC Championship, once again broke the 18-hole record with a 273.
 - Broke the school record for best largest margin of victory at the Franklin Street Partners Invitational winning by 49 strokes. Also, won by 33 strokes at the Lady Gator, 32 strokes at the ACC/SEC Challenge, 23 strokes at the Lady Puerto Rico, 19 strokes at the ACC Championship, 14 strokes at the Bryan National and five strokes at the Stanford Fall Invitational.
 - Had all five golfers finish in the top three at the ACC/SEC Challenge (Janangelo 1st; Grzebien 2nd; Nirapathpongorn, Lang and Hardin T-3rd)
 - Had all five golfers finished in the top five of the Franklin Street Partners Invitational (Hardin & Janangelo T-1st; Nirapathpongorn 3rd; Lang & Grzebien (T-5th))
 - From the final round at the NCAA Fall Preview through the first round of the Lady Puerto Rico Classic, Duke recorded rounds of even or under par as a team for 10 straight rounds, which is a school record.

- For the second straight tournament, Janangelo tied for individual medalist honors at the Stanford Intercollegiate. This time with Arizona's Eric Blasberg with a three-day total of 209. Janangelo struggled on the final day with a 74.
- Had a string of six straight rounds of even or under par broken on the final round of the Stanford/Pepsi Intercollegiate.

- Won the individual title with a school-record 36-hole total of 134 at the ACC/SEC Challenge. Had a tournament record 65 on day two. The 65 also tied a school record. The victory marks the third straight week she has either finished first or tied for first.
- Led going into the final round at the Lady Puerto Rico Classic and ended up losing the individual title by two strokes with a 215.
- Had the only even-par final round at the Lady Gator Invitational.
