Notes

- Head coach Joanne P. McCallie needs only 11 victories to reach 600 for her career
- Duke returns the high-scoring duo of Rebecca Greenwell and Lexie Brown, who combined to average 34.7 points a game in 2016-17
- Blue Devils will feature three graduate school students in 2017-18 as Lexie Brown, Rebecca Greenwell and Bego Faz Davalos are attending the Duke Fuqua School of Business - MMS Program.
- Bego Faz Davalos transferred in from Fresno State where she will have one year of eligibility. She is a two-time Mountain West Defensive Player of the Year and is the NCAA active leader in rebounds (896), blocks (346), blocks per game (3.46) and double-doubles (37).
- Duke traveled to Italy Aug. 14-23 to play three contests and go sightseeing. The Blue Devils went 2-1 in the games with the only loss coming without Brown, Greenwell and Davalos as they returned to Duke Fuqua.
- After missing most of her first two seasons, Haley Gorecki is expected back at full strength in 2017-18. She missed time with a hip injury and has not played since early January of 2016.
- Junior Kyra Lambert tore her ACL in the 2017 NCAA Tournament first round and her timetable for return is unknown.
- Head Coach Joanne P. McCallie enters her 11th year at Duke. She became the first NCAA Division I Head Coach to be named conference coach of the year in four different leagues and the first coach to lead teams to conference championships in four different leagues. She has won ACC Coach of the Year in three out of the last seven seasons.
