**Andy Ferguson** (2008-11) | P | [Stats](#)  
**Organization:** Kansas City Royals, Double-A, Texas League  
**Current Team:** [Northwest Arkansas Naturals](#)  
**MLB Draft:** 18th Round (Kansas City Royals)

**What's New:** Ferguson was injured most of the 2017 season and was limited to just three rehab appearances with the Arizona Rookie League Royals. He tossed 2.1 innings and struck out five while only walking one. He didn't allow a hit in the short stint.

**What's New:** Owen ended the year on the 7-Day Disabled List, but pitched to a 3-1 record with a 5.64 ERA in 67 total innings that included a short stint in Triple-A. He struck out 53 batters across both levels and only walked 19.

**MLB Draft:** 35th Round (Pittsburgh Pirates)

**What's New:** George enjoyed a great 2017 season with a .302 batting average, .386 OBP, and .466 slugging percentage across two levels. He hit 24 doubles, two triples, and 10 homers and drove in 61 runs, while only striking out 57 times and walking 48 times.

**What's New:** Wright finished with a 4.58 ERA in 19.2 MLB innings with 11 strikeouts and eight walks. He went 6-10 in Triple-A and registered a 6.99 ERA with 61 strikeouts in 92.2 innings pitched. He was outrighted off the 40-man roster on Sept. 7.

**What's New:** Lee threw 24 total innings in two levels after missing all of the 2016 campaign. He tallied a 1-2 record with a 7.88 ERA and had 14 strikeouts in all. He pitched to a 4.91 ERA at the High-A level with an 0-1 record before going 1-1 in Double-A.

**What's New:** Zuber became the highest drafted player in the June Amateur Draft in school history when he was selected with the 180th pick. He pitched to a 3.62 ERA with 39 strikeouts in 27.1 innings pitched. He pitched to a 1-0 record with six saves.

**What's New:** Caceres tallied a 6-7 record with the New Jersey Jackals and recorded 93 strikeouts in 83.2 innings pitched. He allowed 73 hits and registered a 6.35 ERA in 18 games with 16 being starts.
